LOWER MAINLAND AREA CADET MARCHING BAND DISPLAY / COMPETITION JOINING INSTRUCTIONS – 12 MAY 24

#### General

1. The subject Cadet Marching Band display will be held on Sun 12 May 24 from 1230-2030 hrs at the Abbotsford Exhibition Park, 32470 Haida Dr, Abbotsford. Annex B will identify the day's schedule.

#### Dress

- 2. Civilian Dress is authorized throughout the day with the following exceptions:
  - a. Competition Staff: No. 1A / Professional Attire for Civilians
  - b. Band Officers/Supervisors: No. 1A for Performance & Closing Parade
  - c. Cadets: C1 for Performance & Closing Parade
- 3. Due to limited space for changing, after the band has performed, it is recommended that the members stay in uniform for the duration of the day.

#### **Band Identification**

4. Bands are asked to complete the <u>Band Identification Form</u> to confirm Drum Major and band size, and dietary restrictions by **NLT 29 Apr 24**.

#### Transportation

5. Based on unit location, transportation has been arranged and Corps/Squadrons have been advised and will be in the Travel Plan at Annex A.

#### Rations

6. Food will be provided to the participants, accompanying Officers and Staff.

#### Medical

- 7. First Aid qualified staff will be present at the activity. Injuries to Cadets or Staff will be noted on a DND 2299 or CF98 as appropriate. The nearest emergency medical facility is Abbotsford Regional Hospital, 32900 Marshall Rd.
- 8. Corps/Sqn staff are to confirm the Participation Limitations in Fortress before the activity. Supervising Officers will be responsible manage medication requirements and will hold countermeasures (EpiPens) for cadets who require them.

## Site Map

- 9. A site map is located at Annex C and specifies the following locations:
  - a. Registration & Warm-up space;
  - b. Inspection building & Equipment Storage; and
  - c. Performance floor.

#### In Routine & Registration

- 10. Band Officers are to report to the registration table for in-routine.
- 11. Bands are encouraged to attend the entire day to support their fellow musicians, but at a minimum should arrive 1 hour prior to scheduled time for inspection as indicated at Annex B.

#### Seating Area

12. First come, first served in chairs for cadet and spectators.

#### Security

13. Cadets are discouraged from bringing attractive and expensive items to the Display. All cadets are responsible for their own equipment.

#### Adjudication for the 2024 competition

14. As there is no preceding year for reference, bands have self-identified their competition category. Scoring will be IAW Ref A.

15. Bands will be provided their adjudication paperwork at the close of the competition to review for further development.

## Duties and Responsibilities of Escort Officer/Band Officer and Assistants

- 16. Band Officers will:
  - a. always be responsible for the behavior of their cadets;
  - b. must carry at all times a nominal roll with medical numbers;
  - c. Hold copies of blank DND 2299;
  - d. Have a basic medical kit to assist if an emergency occurs; and
  - e. Ensure timings are met IAW Annex B Performance Schedule.
- 17. The competition area is a performance venue, and all attendees must be respectful to the performing bands. This does not preclude cheering and/or clapping as is appropriate to the performance.

#### Final Award Parade

- 18. The Final Awards Ceremony for the Marching Bands will be held at the end of all displays and cadets will form up in their bands for the presentations. During the final parade the following selections available via T-PAC- Music Musique will be played by selected and/or massed bands:
  - a. "O Canada" played by Selected or Massed Band(s);
  - b. "God Save the King" played by Selected Band(s);
  - c. "General Salute" played by Selected Band(s)
- 19. The parade proceeds as follows:
  - a. march-in music each Band performs 16 measures of their choosing and cuts off;
  - b. "General Salute" is to be played by a designated band
  - c. <u>"O Canada"</u> is to be played by a designated band;
  - d. awards;
  - f. cadets aging out to be recognized;

- a. the second "General Salute" to be played by a designated band;
- b. "God Save the King" to be played by a designated band;
- e. march-off music each band plays 16 measures of their choosing and cuts off.
